This ride will also encompass part of the August "Ride & Camp" which is to ride the perimeter of the State of Wisconsin.

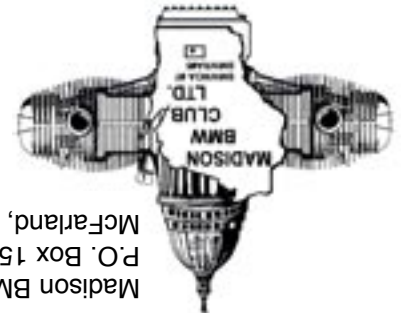
