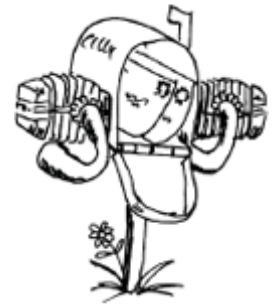

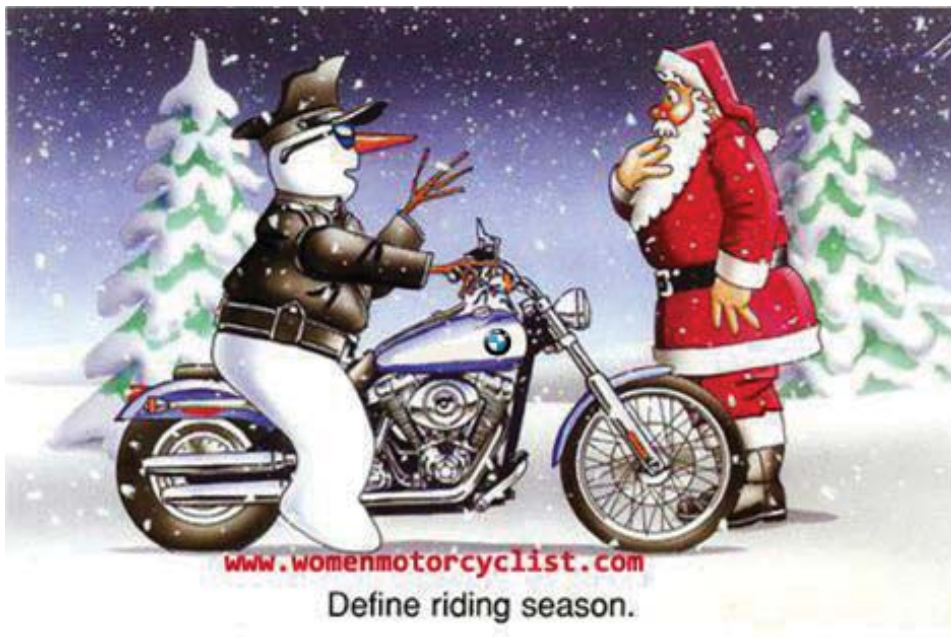
Greetings!

I had a chance to speak with Joyce's sons at the visitation. They told me how much she loved riding with their dad, participating in rallies, and being a member of the Madison BMW Club. She will be missed greatly by all who knew her.



Joyce Joan Skinner, 66, of Fort Atkinson, passed away on Friday, Nov. 13, 2015, at her home, following a struggle with Leukemia.

Joyce was born on July 9, 1949, in Madison, to Henry and Clara (Strobach) Freudenthal. She graduated from Middleton High School and the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh with a bachelor of science in Education.



Joyce married Richard Skinner on June 16, 1972, at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Middleton. She taught in the Beaver Dam School District for six years, and also was a substitute teacher in Fort Atkinson and neighboring towns. Joyce retired in 2011 from the Fort Memorial Hospital after 17 years as a medical transcriptionist.

Joyce is survived by Richard, her husband of 43 years; and their two children, Douglas (Eve) Skinner and Brian Skinner of Fort Atkinson. She also is survived by her two sisters, Nancy Schwartz of Middleton and Helen (Stan) Endres of Lodi.

You are a Blessing.**

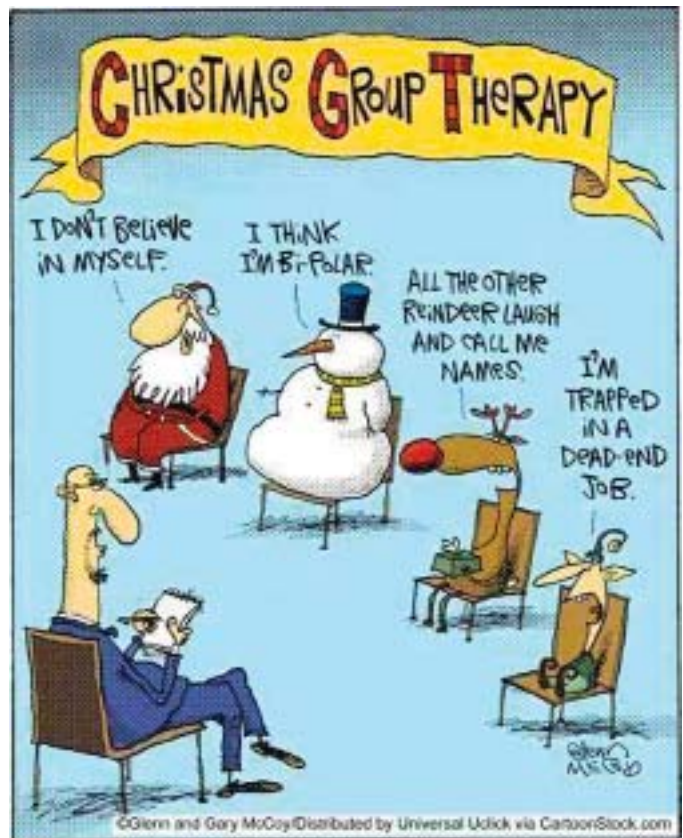

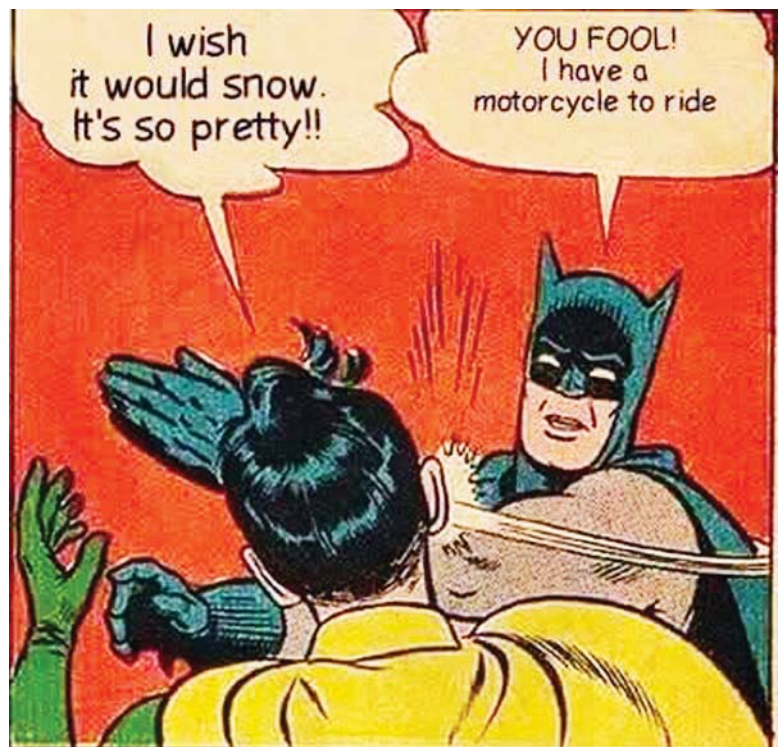

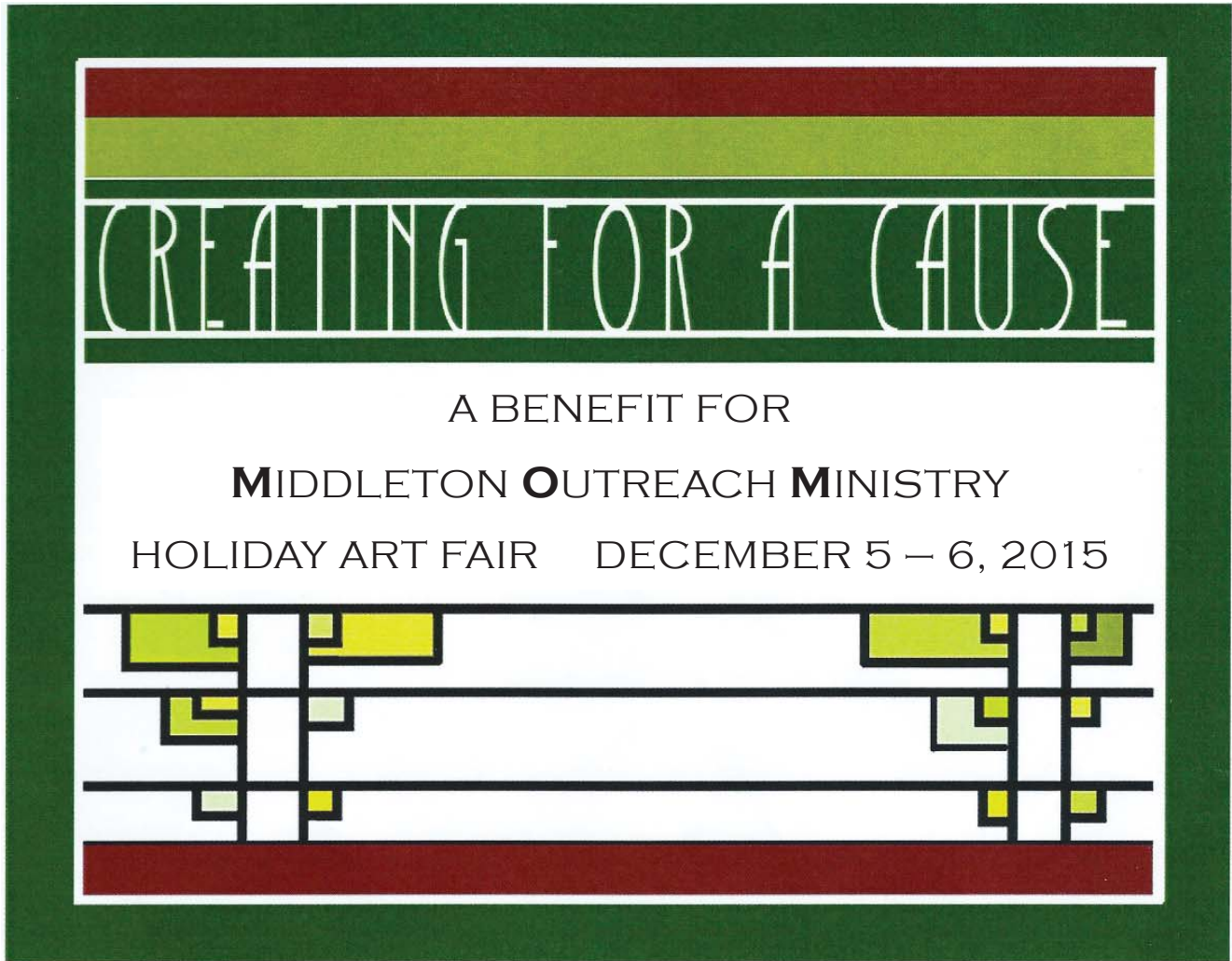
